The Mustard Seed Education Foundation provides scholarships to active, Catholic families who demonstrate need, and who may fall outside the parameters/requirements of other scholarship/tuition-assistance opportunities, and who choose to educate their children at Most Blessed Sacrament School in the Diocese of Toledo. The foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation founded in 2018. Currently, the scholarships are only available to families choosing to send their children to Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School, Toledo, Ohio. As the foundation takes root and grows, like the mustard seed, it may branch out to area parish schools.

Mission Statement

The Mission of the Mustard Seed Foundation is to help committed, Catholic families achieve the dream of sending their children to Catholic Grade School.

The Mustard Seed Education Foundation offers three, one-time scholarships:

- **The Scholarship of the Mustard Seed: \$1000**
Awarded to a committed, Catholic family sending their children to Most Blessed Sacrament School. This family helps spread the word of God in the Most Blessed Sacrament Parish community and brings others into the Faith. The family must be registered, active parishioners, engaging in the parish through volunteering and attending Mass regularly.
- **The Scholarship of the Offering: \$2000**
Awarded to a committed, Catholic single parent whose children attend Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School. This award is based on financial need. The family must be active, registered parishioners, engaging in the Parish through volunteering and attending Mass regularly.
- **The Scholarship of the Good Shepherd: \$2000**
Awarded to a committed, Catholic family whose child attends a public school and is interested in transferring to Most Blessed Sacrament. The family must be active, registered parishioners, engaging in the parish through volunteering and attending Mass regularly.

Families who meet the criteria for an award may request an application through the Most Blessed Sacrament School office. School families, faculty and parishioners may also nominate families for consideration by contacting the foundation at info@mustardseededucation.org. All applicants who are not awarded a scholarship may reapply the following year.
