The Mustard Seed Education Foundation provides scholarships to active, Catholic families who demonstrate need, and who may fall outside the parameters/requirements of other scholarship/tuition-assistance opportunities, and who choose to educate their children at a Catholic School in the Diocese of Toledo. The foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation founded in 2018. Currently, the scholarships are only available to families in the St. Joseph Catholic Church community in Maumee, Historic St. Patrick Church community and Most Blessed Sacrament Parish community, Toledo, Ohio. As the foundation takes root and grows, like the mustard seed, it may branch out to area parish schools.

Mission Statement

The Mission of the Mustard Seed Foundation is to help committed, Catholic families achieve the dream of sending their children to Catholic Grade School.

The Mustard Seed Education Foundation offers the following one-time scholarship:

- **The Scholarship of the Mustard Seed: \$1000**

Awarded to a committed, Catholic family in St. Joseph Catholic Church community in Maumee who has a child at a public school and would like to attend St. Joseph Catholic School in Maumee or is already enrolled at St. Joseph Catholic School in Maumee. The family must actively engage in the Parish Community through volunteering at Parish events and attending Mass regularly.

Families who meet the criteria for an award may request an application through the St. Joseph Catholic Church office. School families, faculty and parishioners may also nominate families for consideration by contacting the foundation at info@mustardseededucation.org. All applicants who are not awarded a scholarship may reapply the following year.
